



The Millennium Innovation Competition aims to inspire high school students to explore innovation and emerging technologies while fostering deeper engagement with STEM fields – science, technology, engineering, and mathematics.

As a strategic partner, Liberty proudly supports this initiative to help cultivate the next generation of innovators and problem-solvers.

In 2024, 11 finalist teams from schools in Tbilisi, Kutaisi, Senaki, Batumi, Zugdidi, Akhmeta, and Mtskheta presented groundbreaking projects across diverse areas including space, aviation, robotics, mobile technologies, environmental protection, healthcare, energy, and transportation.

Students from Kutaisi Physics and Mathematics School No. 41, Skhivi School, and St. Alexi Shushania Orthodox Gymnasium developed an unmanned boat designed to detect oil spills and automatically clean contaminated marine waters using specialized filtration systems.

#### Second Prize Team: Starfish

Students from Batumi Public Physics & Mathematics School No. 6, the American International School "Progress," and Batumi Andria the First-Called School

created a smart, eco-friendly fish farm.

With funding from GITA (Georgia's Innovation and Technology Agency), the team will attend the ID Tech Camp at Stanford University.

Students from Newton Free School designed a smart drone capable of detecting pests in crops.







### 06. **KNOWLEDGE SHARING: VOCATIONAL SCHOOLS**

In 2019, Liberty launched Georgia's first strategic partnership with vocational institutions, with the goal of advancing vocational education and aligning it with the evolving needs of the business sector.

As part of this initiative, Liberty established fully equipped banking service simulation labs at partner colleges, enabling students to apply theoretical knowledge in a practical setting. For many participants, Liberty became their first professional workplace.

Trainers from Liberty's internal Training Center regularly deliver specialized sessions to help strengthen the qualifications of vocational school instructors.

Additionally, all students enrolled in financial services programs at partner institutions completed their mandatory internships at Liberty branches, gaining valuable real-world experience as part of their academic development.

In recognition of its ongoing commitment, Liberty was awarded the "Business Partner of Vocational Education" honor in 2024.

### LIBERTY FOR EQUAL OPPORTUNITIES

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In 2024, as part of the Inclusive Environment and Equal Opportunities initiative, Liberty, in partnership with the Georgian Development Foundation (GDF), began implementing physical and service-level accessibility improvements across its operations. Liberty is the first financial institution in Georgia to develop an accessibility standard that aligns with both global benchmarks and national legislation.


#### As part of the program:

- A formal Inclusivity Policy document was adopted
- A Physical Accessibility Guide was developed and approved
- The adaptation of selected branches commenced, due by the end of the year
- Customer Service procedures for serving people with disabilities were updated and approved

Liberty's Training Center, in partnership with GDF, also created a specialized "Inclusive Customer Service" training module, delivered in both online and in-person formats. This included Training of Trainers (ToT) sessions to scale knowledge across the organization.

## O1. MyCoc MOBILE TELECLINIC

Now in its third year, MyDoc is a mobile telemedicine project tailored to Liberty's older-generation customers, located mostly in regions.

In 2024, the MyDoc teleclinic - equipped with advanced medical technology - visited 608 villages and provided free health screenings to 7 432 customers.

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## LIBERTY IN SUPPORT OF THE ENVIRONMENT

Since 2021, Liberty has enforced a formal Environmental and Social Risk Management Policy. In 2024, in partnership with the state program 'Produce in Georgia' and the World Bank, Liberty actively financed eco-friendly businesses.

Through technical assistance from the European Investment Bank (EIB), Liberty developed the following key documents:

- Climate Risk Management Framework
- Climate Change Action Plan
- Green Financing Strategy
- Green Financing Framework

A Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Emissions Tracking Tool was also introduced to monitor the bank's environmental footprint.

To ensure proper execution, a dedicated ESG Working Group was formed in 2024, and multiple training sessions were held on:

- Climate risk
- Green financing terms and principles
- Sustainability best practices

These efforts directly contribute to Liberty's own sustainability targets and to Georgia's national climate strategy.

### PAPERLESS SOLUTIONS Signify Pads

In 2024, Liberty introduced Signify Pad – a digital signature solution developed in collaboration with the Signify platform. This service innovation is being implemented for the first time in Georgia and aims to digitize customer service processes and significantly reduce paper use across Liberty branches.
